Parents of all incoming 7th grade and kindergarten students in fall of 2010:
New vaccine requirements have been established by the Centers of Disease Control

Fulton County Health Department

- ✚ It is now a requirement that all seventh grade students be vaccinated against tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (whooping cough). One vaccine is available that will prevent these three diseases. It is called **Tdap**.
- ✚ Fulton County Health Department has **Tdap** available during immunization clinics: **Every Friday from 8:30AM-12Noon; first and third Thursdays from 2:00-6:00PM**
- ✚ Cost of vaccine is \$10.00
- ✚ No one will be denied state provided vaccines due to inability to pay

Two doses of chickenpox vaccine are now required for Kindergarten entry.

Other Vaccines recommended for adolescents:

Menactra: Vaccine that prevents against bacterial meningitis (for ages 2 through 55). Cost is \$10.00 through age 18.

Gardasil: Vaccine that prevents two diseases caused by human papilloma virus. It is now licensed for females and males (for ages 9 through 26 years). Cost is dependent upon insurance coverage.

Hepatitis A: Vaccine that prevents against viral hepatitis A of liver (ages 1 through life). Cost is dependent upon insurance coverage.

Varivax: Vaccine for the prevention of chicken pox, if not immune to disease (ages 1 through life). Cost is \$10.00 through age 18.
