Bids will be accepted at the office of the Fulton County Commissioners, 152 S. Fulton St., Suite 270, Wauseon, Ohio, until **10:30 A.M., Monday, April 27, 2009** at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

- II. The bidder is required to fill in all the blank spaces in ink.
- III. The contracting authority reserves the right to waive any irregularities in the bidding procedure that are not in conflict with the Revised Code of Ohio, and the right to reject any and all bids.
- IV. **The bidder shall complete the enclosed affidavit in compliance with O.R.C. 3517.13 (I) (3) prior to submitting its bid.**
- V. **The bidder shall complete the enclosed Ohio Department of Public Safety's Declaration Regarding Material Assistance/NonAssistance to a Terrorist Organization prior to submitting its bid.**

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

### I. BID FILING

Bids shall be on the form prescribed by the contracting authority and filed in a sealed envelope at the time and place mentioned in the advertisement. The bids received shall be opened and tabulated at the time stated in this notice. Each bid shall contain the full name of each person or company submitting the bid.

### II. BID GUARANTY

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 307.88, each bidder shall be required to file with his bid a bond or certified check, cashier's check, or money order on a solvent bank or savings and loan association in an amount equal to five (5%) percent of the bid, conditioned that he shall, if his bid is accepted, execute a contract and deliver the unit in conformity to the invitation and his bid.

### III. AWARDING OF CONTRACTS

The award of the contract shall be based upon the best combination of the following factors: Cost, equipment furnished, and delivery date. The bond or check from all unsuccessful bidders shall be returned to them by the contracting authority immediately upon awarding the contract or the rejection of all bids. ### IV. SPECIFICATIONS

PRE-OWNED aggregate spray road repair and pothole patcher, trailer mounted, to meet or exceed the following minimum specifications. Failure to note any exceptions may result in a bid disqualification.

GENERAL: To be equipped to hitch to a dump truck. Patcher shall be capable of delivering aggregate size –  $\frac{3}{4}$ " down in a continuous flow by a pressurized air stream system. It shall be equipped with a light weight vent flow nozzle. Operator controls for asphalt nozzle and aggregate control shall be conveniently located and easy to operate.

TRAILER: Heavy duty steel frame 12,000 lb. capacity, dual axle, four 7.00 x 15 load range D tires, electric brakes, 2-5/16" ball hitch or pintle eye, brake and tail lights, safety flashing light, and directional signals. Directional arrow board mounted on rear of trailer for safety.

BLOWER-VAC AIR CONVEYOR: Hopper box for holding aggregate before entering air stream. Slide gate operated by 12-volt air solenoid and one dual air ram to allow aggregate in to air stream by remote switch at control handle. Shall handle aggregate from  $\frac{1}{4}$ " to  $\frac{3}{4}$ " grade allowing aggregate up to 2-1/2" size to pass through without clogging the aggregate system. No changes are to be made on the hopper when using a different size aggregate.

TAILGATE FEEDER: Box designed to fit rear tailgate of dump truck. Shall have 5" diameter flex hose for gravity feeding of aggregate into hopper box. No augers or pumps will be accepted.

ENGINE: Diesel, water cooled, 4 CYCL, 80 BHP (minimum).

**BLOWER:** Produce 450 CFM with 7 PSI at 1,500 RPM's using approximately 42 BHP driven directly off engine fly wheel eliminating belt drive. Maximum blower temperature is 275 F. Normal operation is under 230 F.

**COMPRESSOR:** Heavy duty continuous use dual stage with governor. Bolts directly to engine auxiliary drive, eliminating belt. No belt driven compressors will be accepted.

**TANKS:** A 250-gallon emulsion tank, 200 PSI working pressure at 500 F. Insulation R-15 rated covered by a weatherproof fiber reinforced plastic cover that is fire retardant. To have two 1500 watt, 120-volt heater blankets thermostatically controlled. Heating system must be capable of heating an empty tank without damage to the heating system. Tank has pressure relief valve set between 100 PSI and 110 PSI. Pressurized emulsion line. Minimum 3" bottom drain/cleanout valve. Include a tank quantity gauge. A 15-gallon pressurized diesel clean out tank, 200 PSI working at 450 F. Safety pressure relief valve set between 100 PSI and 110 PSI. An 18-gallon (minimum) engine fuel tank.

**AGGREGATE HOSES:** 3-1/2" ID Schedule 40, 10' long connected to a 3-1/2" ID non-kinking reinforced rubber neoprene lined hose 16'4" long for a total length of 26'4".

**EMULSION HOSE:** 3/8" ID hose, 250 PSI rated, 20' long.

**VENT FLOW NOZZLE:** 3-1/2" ID lightweight, perforated tube 13" long. To have a 1/2" by 1/16" spray slot for 100% coating of aggregate. To have perforated holes to relieve air when aggregate exits nozzle to repaired area. This prevents repair material from being blown out of repair area. Nozzle will not use a spray ring to coat aggregate. To include a separate boom mounted nozzle for crack spraying.

**CONTROLS:** All functions using emulsions, engine RPM, aggregate, and horn will be controlled from the operator's station near the end of hose. To include an electric emulsion control to allow emulsion flow electronically or manually.

**HOT OIL HEAT:** 12-volt circulator pump, circulates heated oil through a 2" diameter 4' long pipe inside emulsion tank, then through a 3/8" diameter hose to the emulsion nozzle, then back to the heat exchanger. This keeps the emulsion line warm for cold weather use down to 20 F. Machines circulating engine coolant from engine will not be accepted.

**SWING HOSE CARRIER:** To hold complete aggregate hose off ground to provide easier control for operator. No fatigue design. Tri-flex design. To lock to side of machine during transport for safety and visibility of boom while traveling.
