- **LOCATION:** Fulton County Agriculture Complex and the Defiance College
- **COST:** This year participants may choose to attend all three days for a total of \$110, or may choose individual days at a cost of \$50 per day. Fee includes meals, refreshments, and all workshop materials! Payment must be included with your registration.
- **EARLYBIRD REGISTRATION:** Register by May 7, 2010 and save \$11—pay just \$99. No early bird discount for those attending less than three days.
- **REGISTRATION:** Attendance is limited so pre-registration is required. Registrations must be post-marked on or before Friday, June 4, 2010. (First come - first served basis). Further information and a map will be sent upon receipt of registration.
- **WHAT TO BRING/WEAR:** Rain gear, boots, binoculars, camera, a mug, etc... This is an outdoor/environmental workshop - dress appropriately.
- **FIELDTRIPS:** We will carpool to the sites.
- **LPDC:** Local credits may be available through your Local Professional Development Committee. You will be presented with a certificate verifying your attendance and the number of contact hours.
- **REFUND POLICY:** No refund is possible after June 4th.
- **COLLEGE CREDIT:** 3 hours of college credit will be available through Defiance College. Participant must attend all five days. The cost is \$1,085 in addition to the cost of the regular workshop registration (\$99 or \$110).
