**Resolution 2011-545**

Form an EMS Panel for Fire Chief's Contract and Appoint Dean Genter as Commissioners' Representative

· **Resolution 2011-539** Authorize Create and Renaming of Positions for Sanitary Engineer and Approve Requisition for Water and Sewer Technician I for Sanitary Engineer and Authorize Advertisement of the Same

Ziad Musallam, Sanitary Engineer, was present for the discussion. He stated that a current technician, Kenny Cowell, will be retiring at the end of July and it is necessary to hire a replacement. The current Water and Sewer Technician position being held by Rick Meiring shall be renamed to Water and Sewer Technician II, with the same job duties as he currently holds, while the new position created will be titled as Water and Sewer Technician I. This position will be an aide to the W&S Tech II, will require no license, and will work under his and Rick Meiring's license. This position would go into effect August 1<sup>st</sup> with a 180-day probationary period. Pay is DOQ.

Commissioner Genter stated that for interviewing, he would like the Board to see the list of all applicants. Ziad Musallam and Andy Votava will take the lead on the interviewing and the final 3 candidates will come before the Board for interviewing.

Mr. Musallam noted that this is a 35 hour/week position, with some overtime required, but will flex hours to avoid as much overtime as possible.

· **Resolution 2011-540** Declare Improvement to Pleasant View Wastewater Treatment Plant a Necessity  
Mr. Musallam explained that this is a follow up to their previous discussion on the improvement of the existing Pleasant View Wastewater Treatment Plant. The EPA has determined, pursuant to a sampling of the effluent waters, that improvements are needed to the facility due to the age of the plant and the presence of a pond. After an evaluation, it was determined that the most effective, reliable and feasible improvement is to provide for sand filters and eliminate the existing pond. To prevent further degradation of the area's surrounding environment, the Board is responsible for the construction, operation, and maintenance of the sanitary sewer facilities per ORC §6117.

The estimated cost of the project is at \$100K. A CDBG application through the Water and Sewer Program has been submitted, which, if granted, will cover 50% of the project costs. The rest will be financed through WPCLF for 20 years at 0% interest. Commissioner Genter inquired if Formula funds can be used. Mr. Musallam stated that in his discussions with Steve Brown, if that is the Board's decision, they can apply for that also. He indicated that an income survey of the area indicated that it is 52% LMI which would qualify them for funding through the Formula grant. Commissioner Barnaby instructed Mr. Musallam to do whatever is needed to get any grant funding that is available for this.

Commissioner Genter inquired if an examination has been done of the existing structure out there? The poles in the ground have been there for over 40 years. They need to dig down around those poles to see what is there. Commissioner Rupp agreed stating that a big snow or wind could collapse the building.

Mr. Musallam elaborated on the timeline stating that the improvement must be in place and operational by the end of the year. He will advertise for bids once the funding is in place. The application for the RLF is going out today. The Environmental Review is being done by the Regional Planning Office. That will be sent out as soon as finished also.

Commissioner Barnaby made the motion and Commissioner Rupp seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

It was noted that this will NOT result in a special assessment to be levied or collected to pay for any part of the cost of this improvement and shall be paid for with sewer user charges.
