The properties have twice been offered for sale, but remain unsold. The statute allows an eligible subdivision, respectively, to petition the Board of Revisions to have any or all parcels forfeited to them. Mr. Hall explained that if the properties are forfeited to the County, they will be responsible for maintaining it. He believes the County can however deed it to the CIC. He will get a prosecutor's opinion on this. It was noted that these are residential

		properties in Swanton that are part of a platted subdivision and are landlocked.

Most of this is due to CDARS that have matured this quarter. The weighted yield for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter was 1.67%. For March it was 1.63%, with \$15,205.10 earned in March. She noted a discrepancy in the report due to an \$18K Federal interest payment that was missed. She will send a corrected report.</p> <p>She noted that most banks do not have the collateral to accept new money right now. It is expected that rates will start moving by the end of the year. The Feds will have a first ever meeting on rates on Wednesday. With interest rates as they are, she does not want to go out too far and is keeping some funds in a PNC overnight account to keep them liquid.</p> <p>She noted that a person came in on Good Friday and paid \$10K on their delinquent taxes.</p> <p>The Board thanked her for her report.</p>
