· **Follow-up Discussion on Lawn Care Proposal**

Commissioner Genter stated they have had the opportunity to look over the proposal presented last week by Todd Bingham, County Maintenance Supervisor, for hiring out mowing for county property. As instructed, Mr. Hall confirmed that Mr. Bingham did forward the other proposals received during this process to him and he has looked them over. Commissioner Genter noted that the cost of \$30 per mow for lawnmower maintenance most likely did not include the price of the lawnmower itself. Taking that into consideration, that number would be more like \$70 per mow. Labor and fuel on top of that is in excess of \$1000/mow. The lowest proposal came in at \$765/mow.

Commissioner Barnaby stated that he would go along with this for the rest of this year but it should be bid out in the future to ensure they don't cross the \$25K threshold. Commissioner Genter noted that for the rest of this year, \$765/mow x 20 weeks only computes to \$15,300, well below that threshold.

**•Review Draft of 9-1-1 Protocol Policy**

As they continue to look at the EMS system, the Board reviewed a draft of the proposed policy sent by Richie Kilgour, 9-1-1 Coordinator. The proposed policy is to determine full-arrest just based on a phone call. Commissioner Barnaby stated that first they should talk to the Sheriff to see if he's in favor of the proposal. Commissioner Genter stated that the Sheriff is in charge of 9-1-1 and there is a 9-1-1 Advisory Board. They want to make sure they are going through the proper channels to get a policy in place. He added that automatic aid is what is needed.

The Board wishes to have Mr. Rod Cheney, EMS Director, pull together another meeting to keep this moving.

**•Review Draft of Policy Regarding Adoption of Pit Bulls**

Following up to last week's discussion, Deputy Dog Warden, Brian Banister, forwarded a proposed policy regarding the adoption of pit bulls.

"No Pit-bull or Pit-bull mixes will be adopted to the general public or rescue group from this facility. Pit-bulls that are to be claimed by the owner will be released providing they are in accordance with O.R.C. §955.22 regulations and local ordinances per the village they originate from. A valid court order may also be required to release said dogs. This policy is formatted by the Fulton County Commissioners as well as the Fulton County Dog Warden."

Commissioner Genter suggested that this go to the Prosecutor for review to ensure proper implementation.

**•Discuss Regional Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy**

Lisa Arend, Economic Development Director, was present for the discussion. Fulton County is currently part of a 5-county CEDS. The strategies in the Regional CEDS are different. The Regional CEDS involves Lucas County also. She presented the Board with the 2012 EDA Regional CEDS Budget. Participation will cost \$2,500 for Fulton in addition to a \$5,000 in-kind match. Counties with a strategy in place will have access to EDA dollars. Grant money is available to make application. Commissioner Genter stated that they need to be careful as to where they commit. They should know who is in charge of the dollars and where the dollars flow. He stated that we need to be mindful of what we are tying into. The majority of the west side of Fulton County is rural and most of the residents would like to keep it that way. We need to be able to maintain flexibility. If we don't get a vote, it will not be good for Fulton County. Ms. Arend stated she would have further information available to bring back on Thursday.

Mr. Ziad Musallam, Director of Public Utilities, was present for the discussion. He gave a brief overview based on Resolution 2010-190 passed by the Board of Commissioners to approve the water use rules and regulations to operate and maintain the Northeast Water System. Further rules and regulations are required by the EPA, the Ohio Administrative Code and the Ohio Revised Code to ensure the protection of a public water system from contamination due to backflow through the water service connection.

Mr. Musallam explained the rules and regulations as presented allow them the right of entry, with notice, to do surveys and investigations of premises to make sure there is no danger of a cross connection. The rules further identify what will be done if an area is determined to need protection.

Commissioner Rupp inquired how many users are on this line. Mr. Musallam stated there are 497, mostly residential. Commissioner Rupp then inquired of the timing of the project. The time is undetermined as Mr. Musallam explained that it would take some time to set up the administration.

**Jerry Stewart, Fulton County Airport Operator Airport Update**

- Mr. Stewart reported that the airport painting project is done. The job was forecasted to be a 2-day project. Due to weather, the airport was shut down for a total of 4 days.
- An AWOS I has been approved, which is a lower grade than what was applied for. They really need an AWOS III, which includes air temp and dew point, in addition to the features of AWOS I, which reads altimeter and wind info. It is the general consensus of the airport board that they take what they can get, and build it from there. He questions if further efforts with the FAA on this would be worthwhile. Commissioner Rupp stated that it never hurts, but indicated that the AWOS I would set all of the site work. The others would be plug-in add-ons.
- He recently sent out surveys to the major industries in the area. He received 6 responses, only 1 indicated uses for aviation for company travel. When asked in the survey what improvements the county airport could make, the answered: longer runway! He is with the understanding that this is on the 10-year ACIP. Commissioner Rupp stated that it is, but the woods to the east side needs addressed. The next project slated is the parallel taxiway. Mr. Stewart questioned why that was, indicating the runway should be a priority. Commissioners Genter and Rupp agreed that the runway should be a priority and that they need to talk through and reprioritize projects. The runway is currently 3,800 feet. At least 4,000 feet would open a lot more doors for the airport.
- The fuel monitoring problem is supposed to be completed this week.
- A TSA inspection was done. They passed with no detriments noted.
- Homeland Security has done an inspection. They passed with no detriments noted.
- FBO report:
  - On May 19<sup>th</sup> he is sponsoring an event at the airport for National EMS Week and the 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Life Flight at the Fulton County Airport. A Life Flight/Fire Dept accident demo will be held; attendees can view the Life Flight Helicopter; airplane rides will be given for \$15 each, with proceeds going to Fulton County Food Bank (FISH); and there will be airplanes on display
  - He plans to hold an aviation seminar in June
  - Getting curriculum established at Northwest State is at a standstill right now. He is being told that they have another project on their plate that needs to be finished first. There is an upcoming presentation scheduled with the Board of Regents. Commissioner Rupp

advised him to let them know when a meeting has been scheduled as the Board is willing to offer help and support.

- The testing center with simulator is doing well.
- He has hired a new person to start on the 28<sup>th</sup>. This is a special ops position to help build his business and will perform functions such as website building, writing curriculum and help work toward his goal of a 135 Commercial Operation.

Commissioner Genter stated that he is doing a great job for Fulton County and is glad he moved here and of what he has accomplished so far. He feels the Board has been proactive in solving issues and as they move along. Mr. Stewart indicated that outside of Toledo, Fulton County has the most active airport around here. The location is attractive to northern Ohio and Lower Michigan. Commissioner Rupp agreed and added that they need to reprioritize the runway extension.

Mr. Stewart stated that he would feel more helpful if he were further involved in the projects going on at that the airport. Commissioner Rupp stated that one thing they are looking at is the possibility of changing the function of the Airport Authority Board. The Authority Board was formed back in the 60's. The biggest difference would be that all of the funds would run through the county instead of them having their own checkbook.
