Final Hearing on Ditch Improvement Petition 2114 Filed for by Larry Vandebusch

Commissioner Genter opened the hearing and turned it over to Chief Deputy Engineer, Rod Creager.

Mr. Creager first gave a brief overview of the ditch improvement process as outlined by ORC 6131. He then gave his final engineer's report as follows:

PROJECT INITIATION

This drainage improvement was initiated through a single county drainage petition filed by Larry Vandebusch and others. The petition calls for the cleaning and brush cleaning of an open ditch known as Branch 7a of Ten Mile Creek located in Amboy.

The watershed involves 285.4 acres and there are a total of seventeen (17) parcels of land within the watershed. Eighty-seven percent (87%) of the area is agricultural land and thirteen percent (13%) is classified as rural residential.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

The primary objective of this improvement is to remove the nuisance brush and accumulated sediment to reestablish an adequate drainage outlet for the Branch 7a of Ten Mile Creek watershed. Another objective is to establish an ongoing maintenance program to keep the drainage improvement in good condition throughout its useful life.

PROBLEMS OBSERVED

The problems observed along Branch 7a of Ten Mile are problems typically found along open ditches that have not been regularly and consistently maintained. Nuisance brush on channel banks impedes the flow of storm water in the channel. Sediment has accumulated in the bottom of the channel blocking farm tile outlets and obstructing the accelerated runoff from roadways and developed properties in the watershed.

WORK PROPOSED

The proposed work plan for this project is straight forward. Nuisance brush that interferes with channel flow will be removed from both banks. The work plan also includes the removal of sediment and the leveling of spoils.

Channel banks will be re-seeded daily as needed during the course of construction. A 15-foot wide berm will be seeded along the top of both channel banks except through areas of one-sided construction.

Rock channel protection will be provided at the upper terminus. Other erosion control measures such as temporary seeding will be included in the work plan as required.

CONSTRUCTION ESTIMATE

The total estimated cost for all of the work proposed including contingencies, construction financing, engineering and administrative costs is \$46,464.41.

PROJECT BENEFITS AND ESTIMATED ASSESSMENTS

Assessments for the proposed improvement are based upon the project estimate and upon the benefits each parcel will receive from the improved drainage outlet. The type and quantity of drainage runoff contributed by each parcel was considered. The location of a parcel relative to the location of the work was also given consideration. Upon completion of the project work plan, final assessments will be prorated to reflect the actual final cost of the work completed.

It was determined that the benefits derived from the proposed improvement over the estimated 20-year useful life will exceed the project costs by a ratio of more than 2:1.

MAINTENANCE

The Ohio Revised Code requires that all drainage improvement projects be placed on a permanent maintenance program.

He presented pictures of the proposed improvement area and explained special assessments for the culvert and brush removal. He explained that the special assessments may be done by the landowner individually. If the county would do the brush they will remove it and pile it for the landowner to dispose of. Cash assessments were also explained.

Commissioner Genter swore in landowners and opened the floor for testimony:

Larry Vandebush, Petitioner, "agree to proceed with the project"

Scott Conrad, Affected Landowner, "agrees also to proceed with the project. It will benefit us greatly."

Sandy Griggs, Senior Center Director Department Update

Ms. Griggs presented the Commissioners with minutes from the Advisory Board meeting on January 9, 2012. The annual election of officers resulted in Jim Wyse remaining President; Jerry Matheny as Vice-President; and Sally Lutz as Secretary/Treasurer.

There are still 2 empty seats on the Board as a result of the death of one member and the resignation of another. One candidate was asked and declined. There are other names circulating for the Advisory Board's approval.

A month, quarterly, and year-end report was given.

Cash on hand is \$1,225,581.60. Total meals prepared in 2011 was 81,309, with 77,829 served. There were 173 seniors receiving housekeeping services in 2011 for a total of 6,203.25 service hours. There were many activities and programs scheduled over the holidays. They usually keep the schedule lighter in January due to weather and road conditions. That is when they plan more "in-house" activities. There were 42 total information and referrals for December. No year-end total was given.

Applications for the Administrative Assistant position will be accepted until January 18th.

Oberlin Farms was able to salvage and recycle about 93% of the house on Clinton Street. Discussions regarding demolition are ongoing.

Commissioner Genter inquired of the monitoring report presented to the Board from the Area Office on Aging earlier this week. He wanted to know what we being done to correct the problems indicated therein. Ms. Griggs stated that they are working with other agencies to get prints of information on shelf stable meals that should be kept in their home in case of an emergency. They bought heat blocks long before this report came out and it was reported that only the meal setting on top of the block stayed hot.

She stated that she is confident that even though it was mentioned in the report that they should have a nutritionist sign off, the seniors are getting what they want. She further noted that in the report it stated that seniors under 60 years old getting meals are supposed to be charged the contract price of \$7.38. Before it was only a suggested donation of \$3.50. Those signs have since been taken down. She is working on a letter of response that is due February 11, 2012.
