We will eat lunch at the Wauseon Senior Center then gather at 12:45 to board the bus and travel to Defiance. We plan to arrive back at the Wauseon Senior Center by 4:15 pm. Andrew L. Tuttle, a lifelong resident of Defiance, bequeathed his extensive collection of Native American artifacts, coins, documents, stamps, military memorabilia and other artifacts to the city of Defiance. The items were cataloged and put on display in the museum named for Tuttle in 2013. The museum is dedicated to preserving the history of the city of Defiance and the surrounding area. IT'S NOT TOO EARLY TO THINK ABOUT MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT

Medicare open enrollment for 2016 will be from **October 15th to December 7th**. Even though August seems early to be talking about it, appointment times fill up very quickly. During Open Enrollment you can enroll in a Part D drug plan or change your current drug plan. Many seniors save hundreds, sometimes thousands of dollars over the course of a year by doing a drug plan comparison. Other changes that can be made during open enrollment are listed below. If you are interested in scheduling an appointment, call Val Edwards at (419) 337-9299.

Changes that can be made during Open Enrollment:

- Change from Original Medicare to a Medicare Advantage Plan
- Change from a Medicare Advantage Plan back to Original Medicare
- Switch from one Medicare Advantage Plan to another Medicare Advantage Plan
- Switch from a Medicare Advantage Plan that doesn't offer drug coverage to a Medicare Advantage Plan that offers drug coverage
- Switch from a Medicare Advantage Plan that does offer drug coverage to a Medicare Advantage Plan that doesn't offer drug coverage
- Join a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan
