SNAP E&T is a program that can help SNAP participants gain skills and find work. SNAP E&T is not a one-size-fits-all training. It meets you where you are and opens the door to new opportunities and career options.

SNAP E&T offers free training, education, and career advice to help you reach your goals. SNAP E&T also helps with things that might make it hard for you to get a job or move forward in your career. Those things could include paying for uniforms, supplies, transportation, and child care.

If you are an able-bodied adult (ABA), joining SNAP E&T may be a way to help meet your ABA work requirement.

You and a SNAP E&T case manager discuss your employment goals, needs, barriers, and strengths.



You join SNAP E&T activities that help you meet your goals.



You stay connected with your SNAP E&T case manager to discuss your progress and receive extra support when you need it.
