NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION (R.C. 3501.03)

The Board of Elections of Fulton County, Ohio, issues this Proclamation and Notice of Election.

A GENERAL ELECTION WILL BE HELD ON
TUESDAY, the 8th day of NOVEMBER, 2016,
(being the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November)

At the usual place of holding elections in each and every precinct throughout FULTON COUNTY or at such places as the Board may designate for the purpose of choosing the following offices: President/Vice President, US Senator, Representative to Congress, Justices of the Supreme Court, Judge of Court of Appeals, State Senator, State Representative, County Commissioner, Prosecuting Attorney, Sheriff, County Recorder, County Treasurer, County Engineer, and Coroner;
and determining the following questions and issues:
